

## LCSA Rifle Range Rules

1. Paper and cardboard targets shall be mounted on backstops provided by club.
2. Clay targets may be placed on center of earth backstops only. NO TARGETS ARE TO BE PLACED ON TOP OF BACKSTOPS
3. Only targets specified in rules 1 and 2 above are permitted without PRIOR APPROVAL by the Board of Directors
4. Shoot straight downrange only. No cross firing at backstops.
5. Eye and ear protection are required for EVERYONE at the range.
6. Members shall carry their membership card exposed in view on their person or range bag at all times when at LCSA. Lanyards are available for a small fee at the clubhouse when the counter is manned.
7. Handgun shooters shall use the dedicated pistol range, unless sighting in long range handguns.
8. Clean up after yourself: pick up brass, dispose of targets, etc. Range trash cans are for trash generated at the range only !
9. Use dropdown warning system when going downrange to set targets. Whenever anyone is downrange, all gun actions shall remain open. Shooters shall step away firearms behind white line on floor. DO NOT TOUCH FIREARMS when warning system is down. It is the SHOOTER'S responsibility to verify the range is clear Before shooting. This includes the possibility of someone downrange and the warning system is down upon your arrival to the range.
10. Shooters shall keep all muzzles pointed in a safe directions at all times. To and from vehicles and moving between benches. Firearms shall NEVER sweep past another shooter !
11. Muzzles shall be kept parallel to ground at all times when shooter is at shooting bench. Do not elevate muzzle at bench. All actions shall be open at all times except when actually shooting. This includes during movement to and from vehicles and between benches.
12. No firearms shall be hand carried downrange, forward of the shooting benches
13. Report any unsafe or prohibited behavior to the Board of Directors or Range Officers
14. No shotgun shells shall be fired at targets on the rifle range, Shotguns with single projectiles ( slugs) may be used at the rifle range Shotguns may be patterned using the patterning board behind the trap fields.
15. No fully automatic firearms are permitted
16. No Binary triggers are permitted
17. No Bump Stocks are permitted
18. Intentionally firing at metal backstop frames is prohibited
19. Use of ammo designed to damage steel swinger targets placed on range by club is prohibited
20. Exploding targets are prohibited, this includes Tannerite.
21. Shooting before Sunrise and after Sunset is prohibited.
22. Shooting before 9 am on Sunday is prohibited.
23. Range is closed Tuesday mornings until 10 am for maintenance.
24. ALL members shall swipe access card each time upon entering and exiting the range gate. This includes multiple members in a single vehicle.
