

LCSA PISTOL RANGE RULES

1. Paper and cardboard targets shall be mounted on backstops provided by club.
2. ONLY targets used and mounted as described in #1 above are permitted without PRIOR approval by the Board of Directors. NO EXCEPTIONS!
3. Shoot straight downrange only. No cross firing at backstops.
4. Hearing and eye protection required for EVERYONE on the range.
5. Members may bring at most 2 guests per day to the range. PRIOR to visiting the range, members must complete a day-use guest pass and pay a \$5 per day per guest fee at the clubhouse. Guest passes and payment envelopes are available in the clubhouse kitchen. The guest pass shall be kept with the guest at the range during their visit.
6. Handgun shooters shall use the dedicated pistol range, unless sighting in long range handguns. Long range handguns (Contenders, hunting handguns, etc.) may use the rifle range.
7. Clean up after yourself; pick up brass, dispose of targets, etc. Use range trash can to dispose of waste generated on the range ONLY.
8. Whenever anyone is downrange all gun actions shall remain open. Shooters shall step away from all firearms, and keep hands off firearms whenever another shooter is downrange. It is shooter's responsibility to verify that range is clear BEFORE shooting.
9. Shooters shall keep ALL muzzles pointed in a safe direction at ALL times, including during movement to and from vehicles to shooting benches, and when changing shooting benches. Firearms shall NEVER be waived past another shooter.
10. Muzzles shall be kept parallel to ground at all times when shooter is at shooting bench. Do not elevate muzzle at the bench.
11. All actions shall be open at all times, except when actually shooting. This includes during movement to and from vehicle, and between benches.
12. No firearms shall be hand carried downrange, forward of the shooting benches.
13. Report any unsafe or prohibited behavior to the Board of Directors or range officer.
14. No shotgun shells shall be fired at targets on the pistol range, except .410 handgun loads. Shotguns with single projectiles (slugs) may be used at the rifle range. Shotguns with shotshells may be patterned using the patterning board behind the trap fields.
15. No full automatic firearms are permitted.
16. Intentionally firing at metal backstop frames is prohibited.
17. Exploding targets are prohibited.
18. Shooting before sunrise and after sunset is prohibited.
19. ALL members shall swipe access card each time upon entering and exiting the range. This includes multiple members in a single vehicle.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RIFLE RANGE RULES IS CAUSE FOR IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP!
